Art assignments for the week of 5/11/20-5/15/20

K p. 78 Read the directions. This week's project is to create a house using simple shapes. Think carefully about how you arrange the shapes, it's important!

1st p. 50 Read the directions. Create a drawing of the inside of a room, any room is fine. Look very carefully for details, they matter!

2nd p. 64 Read the directions. Create a drawing of an animal. If you would like to look at a picture to work from that would be fine. Remember: big shapes, small shapes, details!

3rd p. 72 Read the directions. Create a drawing that tells a story about you. Remember characters, setting, and action.

4th p. 34 Read the directions. This week the project is to create a portrait in correct proportion. You can draw yourself, or someone else, or you can work from a picture if you like. Try your best!

5th p. 124 Read the directions. This week is about symbols, letters. Create an interesting composition using the letters of a word. It could be your name, a favorite activity, or pretty much anything. The important thing is an interesting composition.
