### **Art assignments for the week of 5/04/20-5/08/20**

K p. 56 Read the directions. This week's project is symmetry. The directions say to create a face but anything that shows symmetry would be fine.

1<sup>st</sup> p. 38 Read the directions. Create a drawing of someone special to you. Don't forget a background!

2<sup>nd</sup> p. 42 Read the directions. Create a drawing of a special event. It could be a birthday, a wedding, or the birth of someone in your family, there are so many choices!

3<sup>rd</sup> p. 44 Read the directions. The last few weeks we have been working with the figure. This week it's animals! Create a drawing showing several animals making sure they overlap.

4<sup>th</sup> p. 24-26 Read the directions. This week the project is create a drawing of where you live from above, that's called a bird's eye view. Think carefully about where things like buildings and trees are. Google maps can be very helpful.

5<sup>th</sup> p. 34 Read the directions. This week is about value (lights and darks). Using a pencil create a drawing of a small group of objects, make sure they overlap!
