They may also work on their IXL and Epic accounts for reading and math.

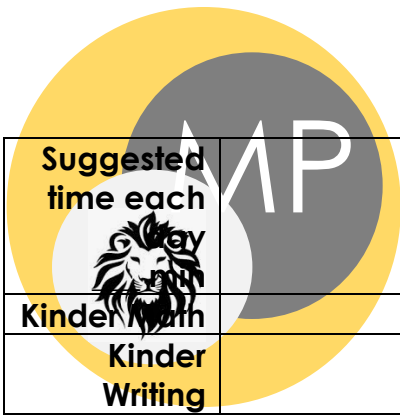

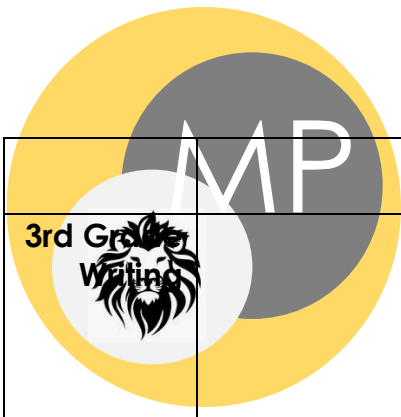
